Home Learning Projects



Please find listed below some fun home learning projects that you can complete with your child at home during this period of school closure. Please refer to our class page for further links to games and songs to help support your child's learning. Please practise your phonics daily, using the letters in your pencil case. You can use your logins to Yumu Music, Teach your Monster to Read and Sumdog too.

The Butterfly Project:

The wings of a butterfly are symmetrical. Can you draw a butterfly and create a symmetrical pattern on its wings?

The Bee Project:

All the bees in the hive have different jobs to do. Think about your family, what different jobs does everyone do? Draw or write about this in your book.

The Beetle Project:

There are many amazing looking beetles, all of different colours and designs. Can you design your very own minibeast? Where does it live?

What does it eat?

Insect Art Project:

Have a go at some transient art. Use objects around your home to create a mini-beast and take a photo!

The Ladybird Project:

We can use books and computers to find out about things. What can you find out about ladybirds? Do a little bit of research and write about them.

The Worm Project:

Worms help to keep our soil healthy. Have a go at growing something at home, some flowers or vegetables. Have fun!

The Spider Project:

Spiders are not insects, they are part of the arachnid family as they have 8 legs!
How many ways can you make 8? Write them all down. (E.g. 4+4=8, 10-2=8)

The Caterpillar Project:

Caterpillars eat and eat until they are big and strong and are ready to turn into butterflies. What things can you do to make sure you grow big and strong?

The Dragonfly Project:

Dragonflies are often found around ponds. Investigate what other creatures can be found around ponds and make a poster about pond life!
