

Penny Wars!

Penny Wars – How It Works

Each class tries to collect the most points by adding pennies to their own container and strategically adding silver coins or notes to other classes' containers to subtract from their totals.

The Rules:

Containers:

1. Each class has one clearly labelled container kept in the office
Children can bring in change each day

Scoring System:

Pennies = Positive Points

Each penny is worth +1 point for that class.

Silver Coins & Notes = Negative Points

2.
 - £1, £2 coins, and paper money subtract from the total according to their value.
 - For example: a £1 coin = -100 points, 20p = -20 points, etc.

How to Play:

3.
 - Children add pennies to their own class container to increase their total.
 - Children add silver coins or notes to other classes' containers to lower their totals.

Collection Period:

4.
 - The Penny Wars will run from Monday 3rd November to Monday 10th November

All containers will be collected and counted after the final day.

Winning Class:

5.
 - The class with the highest net total of points (pennies minus silver/notes) at the end wins a non-school uniform day!

All proceeds will go toward our wish list!
