## PARENT SURVEY

Thank you to all parents and carers who completed our recent survey. Your feedback helps us reflect on our strengths and identify areas for development.

We are pleased that 96% of respondents feel our curriculum is broad and engaging, and that the school promotes positive behaviour, high expectations, and good progress. A further 92% agree that we support pupils' well-being, inclusion, additional needs, safety, and overall quality of education. Safety and well-being remain our highest priorities, and we continue to work closely with families to strengthen these further.
