COMMUNICATION

At Wyburns, we aim to keep communication clear and consistent. Google Classroom is used for all home learning activities, allowing children to access tasks and submit work online. Diary dates are shared at the start of each term to help with planning, but please note these may be subject to change.

KEY REMINDERS

HOME LEARNING

At Wyburns, we believe that home learning plays an important role in helping the children develop independent skills. It also helps to consolidate their understanding and supports their progress. We appreciate your support in encouraging your child to engage with their home learning consistently and to reach out if they need any assistance.

Our Acorns will have weekly sounds and daily reading to practice at home. Once settled, they will also have a weekly maths activity to complete

KS1- weekly sounds and a weekly spelling test, daily reading and a maths activity

KS2- weekly spellings, daily reading, a weekly maths or reading activity. They may also be set a writing activity at points in the year.
