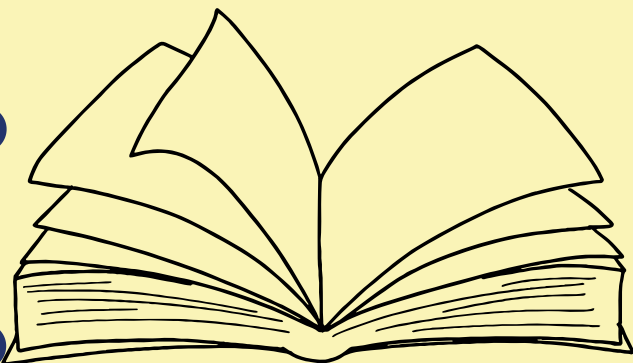

KS2 Pencil Cases
