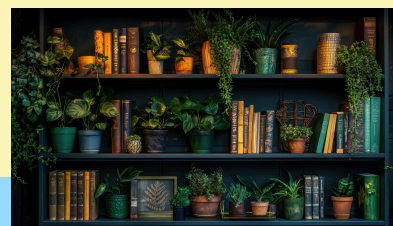
WBD 2026
