JEWELLERY



At Wyburns, our policy states that only stud earrings, a watch, and recognised religious items may be worn in school. Please ensure all other jewellery is left at home to prevent loss or damage.

During PE lessons, no jewellery is to be worn. Earrings must be removed unless your child is within the recommended 6 weeks of having them pierced and a waiver has been signed. If a waiver is in place, please tape your child's ears before they come to school on PE days.

KEY REMINDERS

- Children should wear their PE kit on their allocated PE days.
- Please check our uniform policy to ensure your child is wearing the correct attire – KS2 pupils must wear a tie.
 - Label all clothing clearly to help us return any lost items.

- We are a healthy school – please provide a healthy snack for KS2 children (KS1 receive a fruit snack daily).
- Arrive on time so that learning can begin promptly each day.
